
supercilium often short and diffuse, 'face' appearing 'kind'

slender

flank streaks usually similar in strength to breast streaks

off-white to olive-buff, colour strongest at sides

Prisolone



rather strong

bold, neat streaks

belly whiter than breast and flanks

flank streaks usually *obviously finer* than breast streaks



almost plain upperparts

usually little or no streaking

well-defined dark centres to coverts
